Instructions for treating Hypo/Hyperglycemia in NPO patients

Glucose	Action	Follow-up
>200 mg/dL	• Take ¹ / ₂ usual correction dose (target glucose is 150mg/dL)	Recheck glucose in 4 hours
70-200 mg/dL	• Do not take correction dose	 No action necessary
<70 mg/dL	 Treat with either: Glucose Gel / Tabs OR ¹/₂ cup of clear, carbohydrate containing liquid (apple or cranberry juice, soda) 	 Recheck glucose in 15 minutes Repeat treatment for glucose <70mg/dL

You must remain NPO (nothing by mouth) 4 hours prior to your endoscopy procedure – this includes water, gum & mints.

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
